Summary of academic activities that maintain and/or enhance quality standards.

IQAC

IQAC have informed faculty members of the need to follow University standards in academic course deliveries. The Cell carried out two academic audits during the three-month period. The audit report was sent to the University.

Learning Management System (LMS)

A learning management system was purchased by the Institute. Both teachers and students can access the LMS. Usage of LMS is spreading among faculty members and students. By the end of the semester complete usage is expected.

Universal Human Values

Value Education Cell has been formed. Many teachers attended the FDP on UHV. Fresh students attended three sessions on UHV. The Value Education Cell sends every month to staff and students an informative one-page pamphlet on the concepts of UHV.

Short-Term Training Programme

For the Institution, the Department of Computer Science and Engineering, CSI chapter conducted AICTE sponsored training programme for teachers: "An Induction Program for Young Teachers". The theme was providing technical education with relevance to societal needs. It was a full-day online programme set in two phases, from Nov 16 to 21 and Dec 7 to 12, 2020.

Delivery of Curriculum

Courses were delivered online. Google Meet, Google Classroom, Whatsapp platform were used to teach students. NPTEL materials were provided as additional learning materials. It was a University requirement to adjust online delivery to the needs of students. The needs of students on online delivery were perceived from (i) Monitoring of Heads of Departments, weekly (ii) student interaction, fortnightly (iii) Committee headed by the Principal. Contact class and practical laboratory courses have been set in December. Assessments were carried out online. Audit also pointed to improvement in delivery. As a result, remedial online sessions were arranged.

Teaching, Learning

The enrollment this year was 118, UG and PG. Teachers in service are 68 in number. Closer attention for students is possible. LMS has been introduced. Senior faculty advisor, faculty advisor help and guide students. There are regular Advisory Meetings with students.

Welfare Scheme: Fresh students are motivated with 'Vedavyasa Vignan Scholarship Scheme'. Scholarships are classified according to marks of secondary education.

Community Service

(1) Students and staff designed and fabricated a mobile UV chamber and donated it to Calicut Medical College. Articles kept inside the chamber will be freed from viruses with the action of the ultraviolet rays. (2) Engineering education aspirants were offered a service online with tips to taking the engineering entrance test and to carry out online registration for engineering programme. (3) With the formation of VVIT G9 ENSAV Club, activities towards realizing United Nations Sustainable Development Goals through GREEN 9 Energy Saving Awareness Club, fetched GREEN9 Premier Ensav Club Award 2020. The service consists of student-visits to homes to explain ways to save energy. (4) Awareness on better mental health on World Mental Health Day, Oct 10, was propagated online with FB post.

IT Infrastructure

There are 210 desktop computer systems in two laboratories. Internet service is provided by BSNL (BSNL LL, BSNL NMEICT) with a bandwidth of 40 Mbps. There is a fair degree of office computerization.

Student Support

Fresh students of this year participated in six-day Induction Programme. Yoga, meditation, value education, motivation and other relevant aspects were presented. Remedial coaching, and other academic assistance are offered to students. There is a mentoring system that faculty advisors engage with students. Needy students are referred to Student Welfare Committee. A Student Guild has been formed this year. Sports and Games are encouraged. Campus placement took place despite the pandemic. An MOU has been made with 'Crampete Pte Singapore' for enhancement of e-learning.

Student Induction Programme: e-SIP. The Institute, along with the University scheduled an Induction Programme for fresh students. The programme consisted of inspirational talk, yoga & meditation, introduction to engineering and others of relevance. The programme was intended to ensure a smooth transition to higher education and preparing them for success.

Placement for MTech graduate was facilitated. The civil engineering post graduate was absorbed by PM Constructions.

Alumni Engagement

Alumni Association has 212 registered alumni. They donated Tab and TV for online class to a nearby school. Meetings with alumni take place.

Implementation of e-governance

Online admission is facilitated through links in College web-site. A rank-list is prepared for student admission. Staff administration has biometric scanning, and software usage for salary, and 'Tally' ERP 9.0 aids in income and expense accounting and for generation of reports. Examination functions under KTU e-governance.

Library Service

It is fairly well equipped to serve students. There are 7553 titles in all the engineering branches, engineering economics and management, and general subjects. The number of volumes is 22209. The number of e-books (EBSCO) is 6406, and number of e-journals (EBSCO) 926. National journals in print are 54. The open-source integrated library system *Koha* is in use in the library.

College Bodies

Governing Council, College Council, Student Guild, College Sports Council, Parent-Teacher Association, Alumni Association. These Bodies have been formed this year to help in the development and smooth unfolding of college operations.
