About the curriculum

Institution prepares and publishes academic calendar by listing all major activities of the year. Department activities are planned and executed accordingly. Assignment of courses to members of faculty and time-table, (schedule of work) are completed two weeks before commencement of classes. Faculty members prepare a detailed course plan, course notes, lab manual, for the semester. A question bank is also made that slow learners find useful. Class and course committee meetings are held to inform students that the courses will be delivered by the course plan, with test papers and assignments as stipulated by the academic regulations.

Advisory Committees are formed for each class of a program. Heads of Departments, Department Academic Coordinator, faculty members of the class make up the committee. The committee meets with each class several times a semester, about five times, encourages, motivates and counsels students in their progress towards successful completion of the program.

Practical courses are conducted by norms of the academic regulation. It views each weekly lab session as a serious exercise much like an examination, with 70 marks for the practical work.

A group of 10 to 15 students has a faculty advisor and a senior faculty advisor. The faculty advisor meets with students on an informal basis, discusses their studies with the importance of performance and other co curricular and curriculum activities.

Attendance monitoring with SFA and FA has been formed as the requirement to sit for end semester exam with 75% of attendance.

Faculty evaluation by students - assessed based on the following

- (i) Number of feed backs taken in a semester-2
1st after one month of class, and 2nd after termination of class
- (ii) % of students participated 90%-100%
- (iii) corrective actions were taken for improving teaching effectiveness
- (iv) Regular Formative Evaluation and online feedback mode

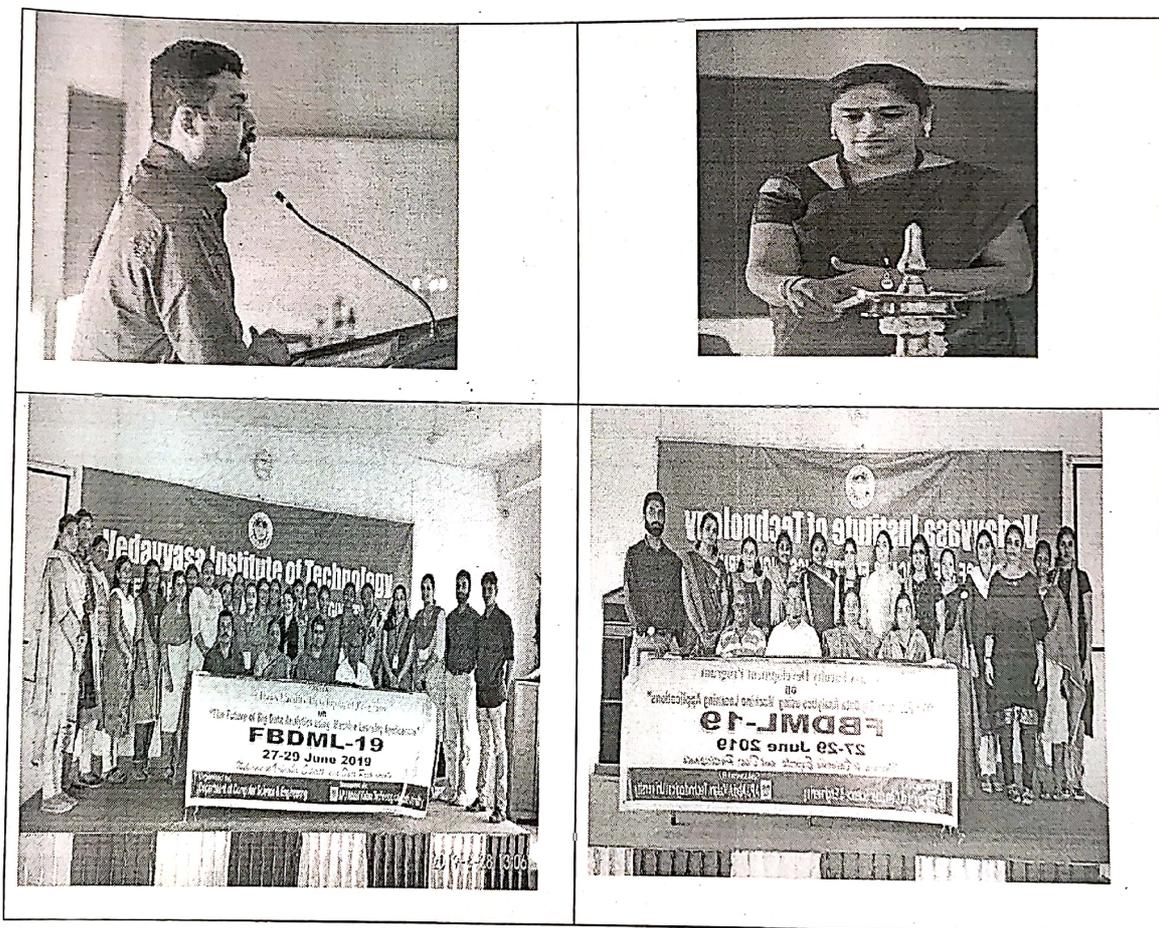
SPORTS ACTIVITIES

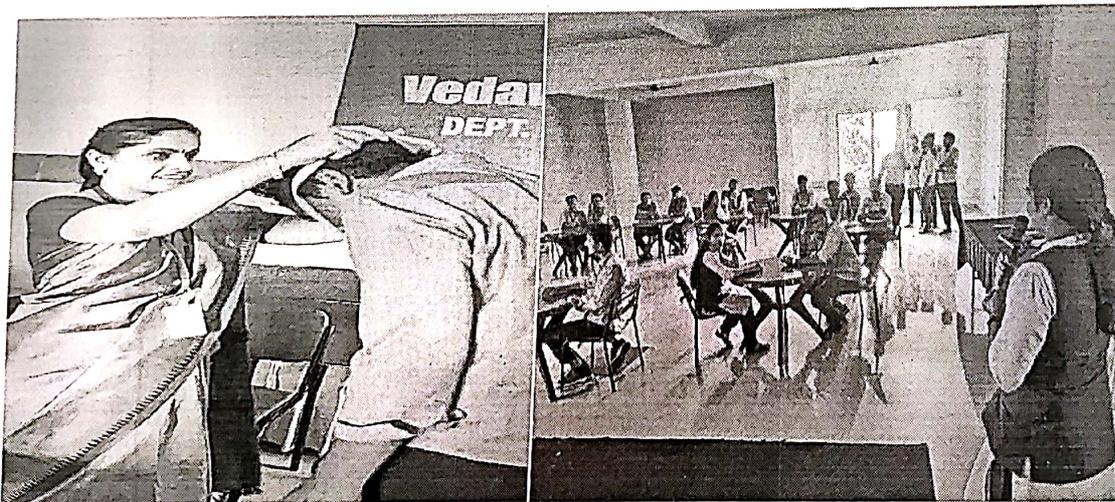


THE NATIONAL EDUCATION DAY

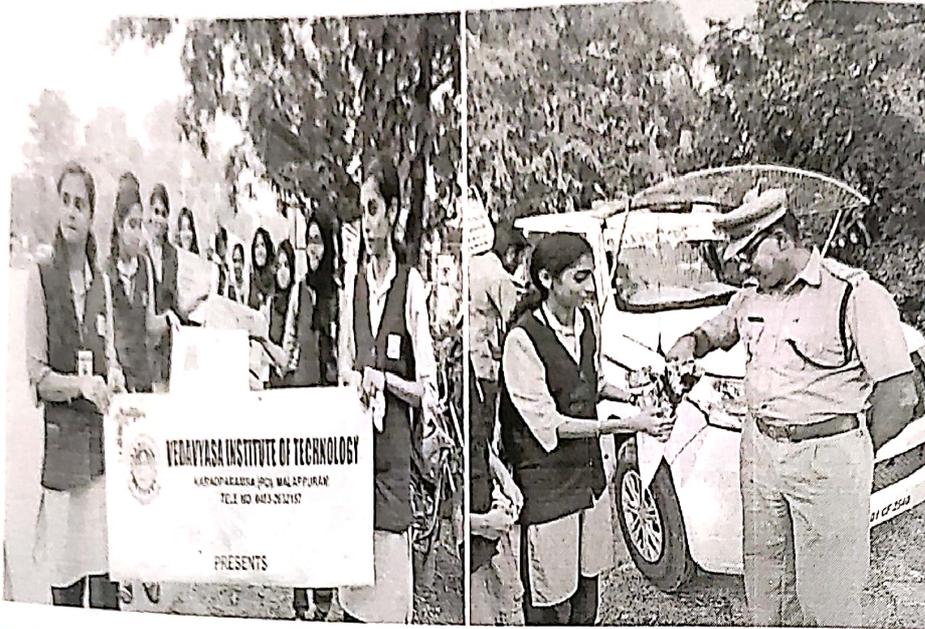

Highlights : The Department of Civil Engineering of Veda vyasa Institute of technology has organised a procession on the National Education day to mark the relevance of education.

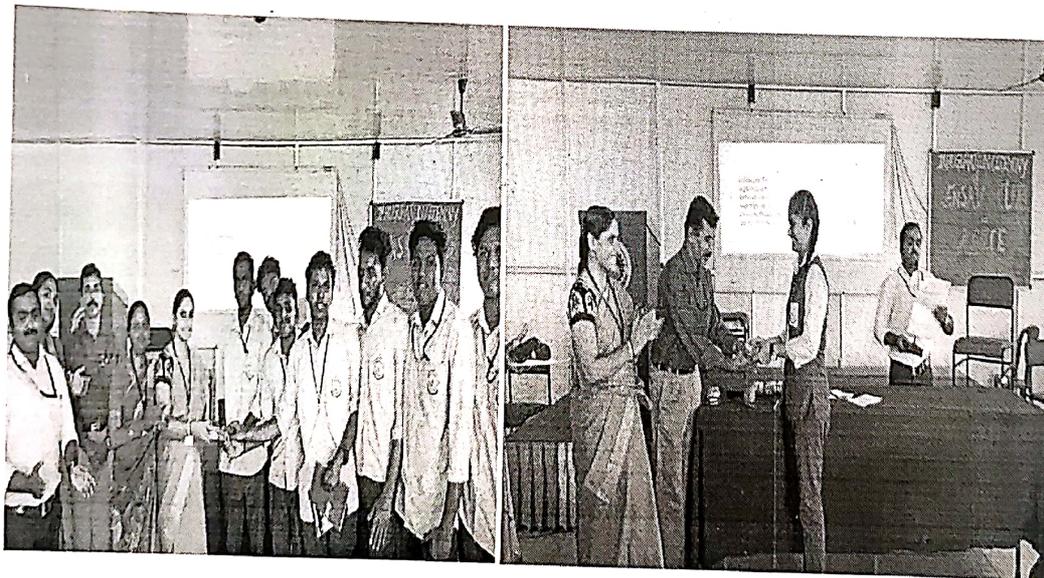


MIPE(Mind Ignition Program for Engineers)
